<p><b>Scenerio #2</b> Jade</p>	<p>Jade heard about TPAN from an employee of the homeless shelter where she stays. Jade visits the site from the desktop computers at the Chicago Public Library.</p>	<p>Found out testing locations and times. Found out about other support services, such as the youth group she belongs to.</p>	<p>Jade found the resources she was looking for, and later contacted TPAN on the phone, and by visiting their offices in person.</p>
